



## **EPA Officials to Answer Questions About Next Phase of Havertown PCP Superfund Cleanup**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is about to enter the next phase of the environmental cleanup at the Havertown PCP Superfund site along Eagle Road.

The next phase of the cleanup will include, among other steps:

- Installation of additional extraction and monitoring wells to address groundwater contamination.
- Excavation, backfill and revegetation of an area behind Rittenhouse Circle and adjacent to Washington Avenue.
- Removing a portion of an abandoned sewer line.
- Ecological sampling to demonstrate the effectiveness of the cleanup.
